



You may be asking yourself; what is "Ticket to Work" and why am I receiving this letter??

The Ticket to Work Program is a free and voluntary federally funded employment program designed to provide Social Security disability beneficiaries the choices, opportunities and support they need to enter the workforce and maintain employment with the goal of becoming economically self-supporting over time.

As your authorized Social Security Ticket to Work service provider, we can explain how to take advantage of the benefits available because you do qualify for this program.

The following are just two examples of what the TTW program offers those who enroll, (we call it "assigning your ticket") in the program.

If you have your ticket assigned with us... you may be exempt from SSA's medical continuing disability health reviews. What a sense of relief that would be!

SSDI recipients are entitled to a nine-month trial work period without risking their SSDI benefits during a 60-month rolling period. There is no limit on the amount of income they can earn during the trial work period.

Your next step is to call and speak with one of our friendly Career Coaches. They can explain the program in more detail. Our services are 100% no cost to you, and there are no obligations to enroll.
